10	Coach arrives in coach park and met by Education Team Welcome and Opening Liturgy introducing the Lent /Easter theme for the day according to the school requirements	
10.30 – 12.30	Divide into smaller groups – (house or tutor groups, led by school staff) for morning activities, which could include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Way of the Cross walk with Pilgrim bags, through the beautiful countryside, exploring the Stations of the Cross, created by different artists. • Meet the donkeys – why are they used and what do they tell us about Christianity. • Drama – watch short ‘encounters with Jesus’ and respond to the performances: <i>what did you think about the piece? What did you like, what surprised you, what would you change? What does the piece tell us about Jesus? / What does this story mean to you? How is it going to make a difference in my everyday life</i> 	
1pm	LUNCH IN HOLLY HALL and outside Holly Barn Theatre	
1.30 - 2pm	Optional activities tailored to group could include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Last Supper sensory experience • A day in the life of a Roman Soldier • Art response time to the cross • Meditating in our busy lives

2.15	Walk down the hill to the coach park	
2.30	Coach leaves site
