Practicalities

You will need a space to walk these stations – whether it is a playground or school field. We recommend dividing into groups of 10 to complete the walk, with an adult leader for each group. Upper KS2 and KS3 could do the walk independently.

At each of the 15 'stations' or stopping points, there is:

- A **picture** to look at and wonder about together – we provide 'Wintershall' pictures, but there are many other images on the internet about this story. For example [here](#)
- A link to the **story** in the **bible**, and a short reflection
- An **object** or action to complete
- A short **prayer** or thought



We will send you everything you need for each child's bag, including a story stone, rosary beads, a wooden heart, crystal tear drops, as well as a mini reflection card in a beautiful hessian pilgrim bag.
