

Wintershall Education Creation Workshop SAMPLE

DATE	Suitable for KS1 – KS3
Time	Activities
10	Coach arrives in coach park and met by Education team.
	Welcome and opening reflection in the Wintershall Barn, using the Godly Play story of Creation.
10.40	Divide into smaller groups led by School staff and Wintershall Education team. Prepare for the Creation walk across the countryside which uses eyes, ears, touch to explore the nature around us. Meet the animals, see the beautiful lakes and walk the hills. Each stop on the walk includes an activity or reflection from the children and item for their creation story bag.
12.15	Lunch in Holly Hall or outside, weather permitting
12. 45	Afternoon optional activities tailored to group could include Laudato Si – a closer look at 'Live Wisely Think Deeply, Love Generously' Art response time – using natural materials to create art Drama 'encounter with Jesus' – what does Jesus say about our wonderful world The Harvest – planting
1.50pm	Liturgy and Reflection time Liturgy with pupils leading the prayers Take some time to reflect one thing you have enjoyed, one thing you have found challenging and one thing you will take away with you.
2.20pm	Walk down the hill back to the coach park to leave 2.30pm

Minimum charge for the day £500 (for up to 30 pupils) and £600 for up to 60 pupils.
