| | wonder what his reaction will be to the news? |
| Elizabeth | Elizabeth is Mary's cousin and is also pregnant. Mary visits her, following her |
| | conversation with Joseph. I wonder what Elizabeth will say? |

MARY enters.

ARCHANGEL GABRIEL appears. MARY is astonished.

GABRIEL Hail Mary, full of grace! I am Archangel Gabriel, messenger from God. You are highly favoured, and blessed are you amongst women.

MARY What? What do you mean?

GABRIEL Fear not Mary, for you have found favour with God and you will give birth to his son, whom you will call Jesus.

MARY But how can this be since I know no man?

GABRIEL Because you will conceive through the Holy Spirit, God's power will come to you. You will have a holy child who will be the Son of God. He will be great and called the son of the most high. The Lord God will give him the throne of his forefather David and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever. His Kingdom will have no end. Even your kinswoman Elizabeth, in



her old age; she has conceived a son and is now in her sixth month, she who was said to be barren. Remember Mary nothing is impossible for God.

MARY So be it. I am the Lord's servant; let His will be done unto me as you have said. My spirit rejoices in God my saviour and I will adore and love him forever.

Angel Gabriel leaves.
