

## Act 2 Scene 17 The Feeding of the 5,000

Taken from Mark 6:30-44, Matthew 14:13-21, Luke 9:12-17; John 6:1-14

CAST	
JESUS	The Gospel stories tell us a lot about Jesus, from the way he behaved – by the way he spoke and treated the people around him. In this scene, he is becoming really well known for doing and saying amazing things. I wonder what he will do next?
PETER	Peter was one of the closest disciples to Jesus, together with James and John. His faith was strong but he was rash and hot headed at times. His original name was Simon.
CROWD- Children & Parents	In this scene, a large crowd of men, woman and children had followed Jesus and his disciples, on foot and coming from the surrounding towns and villages. They all had their own reasons for being there – some wanted to be healed, others were just curious about this man called Jesus Whatever their reasons, this crowd of people had been listening to Jesus for a long time and were now hungry.
ANDREW	A disciple and the brother of Peter and also a fisherman. Called with Peter and James and John while fishing.
JUDAS	Judas was the disciple who betrayed Jesus. Little is known of him apart from the fact that he looked after the disciples' money bag
JOHN	When Jesus called James and John to be his disciples, they were two ordinary fishermen. John is thought to be one of the youngest and closest friends of Jesus, with the Gospel of John attributed to him.

The crowd are all sitting down listening to Jesus before the disciples begin to suggest it is time to leave. Jesus and his friends start to walk off set.

CROWD	(Running after JESUS) Jesus, come back! Don't go! We want to come with you!
PETER	No, you heard the Master. Go home.
CHILD	I'm hungry!
PETER	Go away and find food and shelter for yourselves.
PARENT	We're hungry.
CROWD	We want more stories! We're coming with you!
PARENT	We're all hungry!



ANDREW Peter, they are far from their homes. They need to eat...

JESUS Let us give them food.

PETER We haven't got anything.

JESUS Can we not buy what is needed?

PETER Master, where are we going to do that? This is a remote place and anyway

we have no money. Judas how much money do we have in the box? Have

you collected any money?

JUDAS No Peter, tell him. There's no money in the box. Nothing!

PETER We have no money and anyway it would take eight months wages to give

each man here a mouthful. Let alone all the women and children. Look at

these old dears how are they going to get home without being fed?

PARENT And how am I going to feed my children?

PETER How should I know!? You should have thought of that before you come

here!

JESUS Peter, what do we have?

PETER Nothing. We have nothing Master. Don't look at me like that. Nothing. (He

asks a CROWD member) Do you have any food? (To an audience member)

Do you have any food?

The FOLLOWERS and CROWD walk amongst the audience, asking for food.

JOHN Master! Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two fishes.

JESUS Bring him here.

JOHN But how far will that go among so many?

JESUS John, bring him to me. And form the crowd into groups. And bring baskets.

PETER Come on brothers.

JESUS And you will see.



The BOY is taken to JESUS.

The DISCIPLES take their baskets up to JESUS.

JESUS prays and then fills the baskets to the brim with loaves.

The DISCIPLES distribute bread to the audience, spreading out throughout the crowd and throwing bread to those they cannot reach. The crowd respond with excitement, creating a celebratory atmosphere.

PETER The prophets foretold a Messiah and we have lived to see and hear Him!

Thanks be to the living God!

The CROWD cheers.

PETER Master it is done! All are fed.

JESUS Go and gather up all that remains so that nothing is wasted.

The DISCIPLES and CROWD collect up remaining food.
